
The feature of the GSE

GSE and SES share the same values and operate according to the principles of fairness, neutrality, openness, responsibility and respect. Business partners can rely on this. However, GSE can also offer its support in countries that do not receive funding by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ), and they can take on tasks that are not appropriate when SES funding is involved.

All income generated by GSE is channelled to the non-profit SES, thereby strengthening volunteer work at SES.

The pillars of the GSE

GSE's portfolio includes the areas of consulting, integration mentoring, global mobility and education/TVET *.





Management consultancy: prevention of Insolvency, succession planning, supply chain - the GSE Consulting division

Whether it's the coronavirus crisis, new laws or the desired development of promising business areas: GSE provides the right experts in Germany and abroad.

Germany:

A consultant was able to show a company in Baden-Württemberg ways out of the pandemic-related crisis by reorganizing and put it back on the road to success.

In cooperation with SEQUA gGmbH, a company from the Ukraine was able to present itself at the Nuremberg trade fair and to tap into new customer segments. The GSE expert cooperated with them during the time of preparation and during the fair itself.

Abroad:

GSE also provided the experts for assignments in Bulgaria: Work processes, quality assurance and marketing of a furniture manufacturer and a company producing articles for the hotel and catering industry were successfully optimised.



Integration mentoring: retaining international specialists

If immigrant workers or trainees are well trained and integrated, this increases their motivation and strengthens their bond with their employer. The GSEs accompany them during their first few weeks in Germany, they provide support as volunteer mentors to ensure that the immigrant skilled workers settle in well in their new environment. Valuable help is provided, for example, by the expert who accompanies a structural engineer from Kenya as an integration mentor.

GSE was able to support six people from three countries - Ghana, Sri Lanka and Ecuador - as part of the Baden-Württemberg-STIPENDIUM programme for professionals. Thanks to funding from the Baden-Württemberg Foundation, professionals from abroad complete a professional internship in Baden-Württemberg. As a strategic partner, GSE sought out the internship companies and supported the trainees during their stay in Germany.

GSE's expertise in integration mentoring is also evident in a co-operation with support from the SIGNAL IDUNA Group. Five young men from Ghana, who had completed

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basic training in solar technology at the Don Bosco Solar and Renewable Energy Centre, GSE, together with the German business delegation in the Ghanaian capital Accra and various other partners, helped them to learn the language and prepare for the German exam. The result: all five of them came to Germany for a three-month internship. They have now successfully passed the "German B2" exam and have apprenticeship contracts with companies in Bochum. A great example of a win-win story.



Global mobility: successfully organising secondments abroad

As a specialist in secondment consulting, GSE supports companies in employees abroad. Not only with comprehensive preparation through training and seminars, but also with online coaching during the assignment if required. A special feature: the experts and coaches involve the families, the organisation of private life on site and the personality of the expatriate.

GSE is also the right contact in the opposite case: selected experts support foreign companies that want to send their employees to Germany. For example, GSE imparted its intercultural knowledge to a delegation from Nigeria that had been invited to North Rhine-Westphalia by the Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) to get to know the German labour market.

Education/TVET*: Teaching as the basis for success

Education is a core area of the SES - and the GSE as well.

German schools abroad:

In cooperation with the World Association of German Schools Abroad (WDA), GSE offers German schools abroad the opportunity to react flexibly and at short notice to teacher shortages and cancelled classes. German Schools abroad form a bridge between Germany and the world, and their alumni maintain important social and economic networks. In 2024 retired GSE teachers were sent to schools in Abu Dhabi, Caracas and Paris for the current 2024/25 school year. From February, a teacher will support a collegium in the Netherlands. Further requests are in the validation process.

Cooperation with local educational institutions abroad:

To alleviate the shortage of skilled labour in Germany, the GSEs also support local educational institutions that train highly motivated young people who want to work in Germany. The young people need to be well prepared for training in Germany and have a good command of German. Here too, GSE experts - especially teachers of German as a foreign language - are deployed, e.g. in Morocco or Ghana. Similar co-operations and assignments to provide conceptual support to domestic and foreign educational institutions are in preparation.



United Arab Emirates - Vocational training:

The United Arab Emirates is preparing for economic success even after the era of fossil fuels. For example, through training centres in which schoolchildren are gradually introduced to professions that are new to them. In cooperation with the Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ)**, GSE joined the team here - as an organisation that selects and places experts to strengthen the instructors in the training centres. In 2024, the Department of Wood Technology and Woodworking made the start.

An expert has been there in the field of nursing care since the beginning of 2025.
